Bring The Troops Home Now – Occupation Is Not Liberation

October 28 Pan-Canadian Day Of Action To Take Place In Over 30 Cities

Windsor, ON, October 26 – Over 30 Canadian towns and cities will have public actions on Saturday October 28, to demand that Canada's troops be brought home from Afghanistan now. Listings can be found on the Canadian Peace Alliance website (<http://www.acp-cpa.ca>).

In Windsor there will be a rally at noon in Charles Clark Square, followed by a march through downtown (which will return to Charles Clark Square). Political, labour and community representatives have been scheduled to speak during the rally – and many will be available for comments and media interviews before the march.

As the government issues an urgent order for spare parts for Canada's 25-year-old battle tanks that are being sent to Afghanistan – we are left to wonder when our leaders will finally realize no spare parts can be ordered for the sons and daughters of thousands, who are being killed and maimed around the globe under the guise of building democracy.

“At a time when NATO forces have reportedly killed at least 60 Afghan civilians during operations earlier this week – it has never been more clear, the nature of our presence in this US-led war and occupation and the need to end this charade,” exclaims Rob Spring, one of the Windsor Peace Coalition organizers for the event.
